REQUEST FOR BEST OFFER/PROPOSALS/QUOTATION Completion of BU Polangui Campus Computer Science and Engineering Building (Negotiated Procurement- Two failed biddings)

The BICOL UNIVERSITY, through the Corporate Budget for the contract approved by the Board of Regents intends to apply the sum of ***Nineteen Million Three Hundred Thousand Pesos (Php19,300,000.00)*** under C.O Fund 101 being the Approved Budget for the Contract to payments for the project Completion of BU Polangui Campus Computer Science and Engineering Building.
2. The Bicol University now request for best offer/proposal/quotation from bonafide contractors with valid PCAB Contractor/s License; Principal Classification/Category: General Building/Engineering at least **Category D**, Kind of Project & Size Range: Building & Industrial Plant at least **Small B** to submit bids for the contract. **Completion of Works is required for 240 calendar days.** The bidders must have completed single contract that is similar to this Project, equivalent to at least fifty percent (50%) of the ABC adjusted to current prices using the PSA consumer price index.
3. Procurement will be conducted through Negotiated Procurement under Section 53.1 (Two-Failed Biddings) as prescribed under the 2016 Revised IRR of RA 9184;
4. Bicol University shall hold a negotiation (meeting) regarding the above-mentioned project on **January 23, 2018 at 2:00 P.M.** at BUGASS Conference Room, 2/F General Administration Building, Bicol University, Legazpi City.
5. Contractor shall submit its proposals on or before **January 30, 2019, at 1:00 P.M.** to the BAC Infra Secretariat, G/F General Administration Bldg., Bicol University, Legazpi City;

Bicol University reserves the right to reject any or all bids, waive any defect or informality therein, accept the bids and award the contract to the most advantageous offer to the Bicol University, for and in behalf of the project. Bicol University assumes no responsibility to compensate or indemnify the bidder for any expense or loss that may be incurred for the preparation of bids, nor does it guarantee that an award will be made.
