SUBJECT: Implementation of Flexible Learning during the Nationwide Transport Strike on March 6-10, 2023

In adherence to the unnumbered CHED Memorandum from the Office of the Chair J. Prospero E. De Vera III, DPA, allowing the implementation of flexible learning in view of the impending nationwide transport strike, this Office directs the implementation of said flexible learning on March 6 – 10, 2023. However, this may be terminated earlier than March 10 depending on the situation. Faculty members are further directed to closely communicate with their students regarding this matter. Non-teaching personnel shall report to office or may do work from home depending on the decision of the respective office heads particularly if there is really no other means of transportation for the personnel to report physically to office. Transportation from BU will be made available to fetch those whose services are of necessity for the day.

However, all activities scheduled on March 6, 2023 and March 8, 2023 shall proceed. All concerned officials, faculty members, and personnel are reminded of their attendance to the activities identified in Office Memorandum No 74, s. 2023 with two activities at 1:30 P.M. launching of the Presidents' Memorabilia and at 3:00 P.M. inauguration and blessing of the Women's Dormitory at BU Legazpi (East). In addition to the two activities on March 6, there will also be inauguration and blessing of the Food Science Building at BU College of Industrial Technology at 4:00 P.M.
